



Application for Scholarship Assistance from The Raymond Riefler Trust Fund 2023

This scholarship is open to members of St. James United Church of Christ and the children of members. The Church & Ministry Committee will consider applicants who are either pursuing post-graduate degree programs, or will be college seniors next year. All applicants must be actively involved in the life of the church, and must meet the following terms of the Riefler Trust:

Through moneys from the Raymond Riefler Trust Fund, St. James UCC is able to offer special scholarship help to aid in special training or a degree in the Human Services Field and the dissemination of Christian Education [i.e. special training, advanced degrees, mission opportunities]. The Church and Ministry Committee will recommend that scholarships be awarded to individuals based upon the individual's desire and ability to accomplish this goal. St. James UCC has adopted the following definition of the "Dissemination of Christian Education".

We understand the dissemination of Christian Education to be the calling of all Christian persons. Each Christian individual is given the task of ministering to others - to teach, to serve and to live their life in word and in practice, as expressions of their faith.

As followers of Christ, it is the Christian mission to disseminate the message of faith through service to others. This is the definition of Christian ministry.

Each Christian brings to their ministry the resources with which God has endowed them - their talents, their abilities, their skills, and their knowledge. St. James United Church of Christ accepts this definition of ministry and seeks to encourage the development of God's gifts in varied vocations through study, training, experience and discipline. Christian Education is disseminated through teaching, through service, and /or through living lives which are an expression of faith.

A person pursuing a degree or certification in Ministry, Theology or Christian Education will receive precedence.

The Church Council at St. James receives the recommendations from the Church & Ministry Committee. After they act on these recommendations, they are forwarded to the Buffalo Foundation. Their Board of Trustees has final approval of all scholarship awards. When a student receives their approval for scholarship assistance, the student will be notified, and arrangements will be made to send the scholarship directly to the school being attended.
